WORLD ROSARY DAY – 7^{TH} **OCTOBER:** Pope Francis has asked for a new prayer initiative as a great symphony of prayer leading up to the Jubilee 2025. He has requested that all Catholics pray the Rosary at the same time at 7pm (local time) on the 7^{th} October, the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. Fr. Richard Gibbons has registered Knock Shrine as a venue for the rosary at that date and time and for those who are housebound, or unable to gather at a local level, can join with them online.
