RIGHT TO LIFE: The assisted suicide Bill will be voted on in Parliament in Westminster on Friday 29 November. Although this Bill would change the law in England and Wales, MPs in Northern Ireland are able to vote on this Bill. If assisted suicide is legalised in England and Wales, this will put pressure on Northern Irish lawmakers to legalise assisted suicide in Northern Ireland too, to keep UK legislation consistent on this issue and avoid assisted suicide "tourism". Parishioners are encouraged to use the postcards provided by the disability campaign group Not Dead Yet **UK**, to contact their MP to encourage them to vote against the bill.
